USE OF FLOWERS AND PLANTS

Although the flowers and plants are stationary, they give the appearance of movement. This sense of motion is created by flower stems of different heights within a single bouquet. This effect extends to plants through the use of semi-transparent and stacked plant pots, as well as by the shape of the plants themselves.

Papyrus is an excellent fit for this trend thanks to its flexible characteristics

USE OF COLOUR

Colours from the colour chart can be used in various different ways. See three examples below.

COLOUR KEY 1 | Warm shades from one colour range are complemented by two contrasting colours. This creates a powerfully energetic combination of colours.

COLOUR KEY 2 | Soft and strong colours within one colour range (purple/red). The dark red accent gives this colour combination a spicy look.

COLOUR KEY 3 | This colour combination is slightly heavier than the others. Several strong colours from the main colour chart combine to form an exciting whole.
